DEED OF VARIATION TO THE SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING AGREEMENT

THIS DEED is made the 26th day of August 2025

BETWEEN

- 1) The Secretary of State for Education (the "Secretary of State"); and
- Mosaic Schools Learning Trust (the "Company") a charitable company incorporated in England and Wales with registered number 07824714, together, the "Parties".

INTRODUCTION

- A. The Parties entered into a supplemental funding agreement dated on 26 August 2015 by means of a Deed of Novation and Variation dated 28 August 2024 (the "Supplemental Funding Agreement") relating to the establishment, maintenance and funding of Oak Lodge Primary School (the "Academy") in accordance with the Supplemental Funding Agreement.
- B. The Parties now wish to vary and amend certain terms and conditions of the Supplemental Funding Agreement in accordance with the terms of this Deed.
- C. This Deed is supplemental to the Supplemental Funding Agreement.

1. INTERPRETATION

1. 1 Words, expressions and interpretations used in this Deed shall, unless the context expressly requires otherwise, have the meaning given to them in, and shall be interpreted in accordance with, the Supplemental Funding Agreement.

2. VARIATION OF THE FUNDING AGREEMENT

- 2.1 The Parties agree that with effect from the date of this Deed the Supplemental Funding Agreement shall be amended as follows:
 - a) amending the summary sheet by removing the existing sections referring to "Capacity number" and "Age range" and replacing with the below:

Capacity number (of statutory school age places)	630 plus 21 FTE nursery places
(if the Academy has a nursery provision, please provide a breakdown of capacity for nursery pupils and statutory school age places)	
Age range (including nursery provision where the nursery is part of the school)	2 - 11

b) amending the clause variation summary on pages 5 and 6 by removing the existing sections referring to "2.E.1 and 3.I.1" and replacing with the below:

2.E.1	Only applies to free Schools with nursery provision	✓	
3.I.1	Only applies to Free schools with nursery provision	√	

c) inserting the following definition immediately after the definition of "Coasting":

"Funded Hours" means the current applicable government funded entitlement to free childcare.

- d) replacing existing clause 2.B with the following new clause 2.B:
 - "2.B The planned capacity of the Academy is 630 and the age range is 2-11, plus nursery provision of 21 places. For the avoidance of doubt, notwithstanding that an individual applicant's age might be outside the specified age range of the Academy, the Academy is not prevented from considering an application made by the child's Parent(s) in order to comply with the relevant paragraph of the Schools Admissions Code ('Admission of children outside their normal age group'), to request that the child be admitted to the school outside of the child's normal age group. Where such a request is agreed, the child should be educated in an existing year group. The Academy will be an all ability inclusive mixed sex school."
- e) Inserting the following new clause 2.E.1 immediately after existing clause 2.E:
 - "2.E.1 Clause 2.16 of the Master Agreement does not prevent the Academy Trust charging fees for nursery provisions outside the Funded Hours."
- f) Inserting the following new clause 3.I.1 immediately after existing clause 3.I:
 - "3.I.1 For the avoidance of doubt, the pupil number count for the purposes of determining GAG excludes nursery provision pupils. Clauses 3.A-3.I must be read with this exclusion in mind.
- 2.2 Except as varied by this Deed, the Supplemental Funding Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
- 3. Governing law and jurisdiction

- 3.1 This Deed, and any disputes or claims arising out of or in connection with it, its subject matter or formation (including non-contractual disputes or claims), shall be governed by and construed in accordance with English law.
- 3.2 The parties irrevocably agree that the English courts have exclusive jurisdiction to settle any dispute or claim that arises out of or in connection with this Deed or its subject matter or formation (including non-contractual disputes or claims).

4. Counterparts

4.1 This Deed may be executed in any number of counterparts and by the parties to it on separate counterparts, each of which when so executed and delivered shall be an original, but all the counterparts shall together constitute one and the same instrument.
