

ABOUT THE COURSE

The course is a school-based programme with QTS*. You will be based in schools across the Trust and train with the University of Greenwich.

Applicants should have:

- A good honours degree (2:2 or above) from a UK university or an equivalent qualification
- Grade C (Grade 4) or above in English Language, science, and mathematics at GCSE.
- Candidates are also required to demonstrate suitability to teach through an interview which assesses personal and academic qualities, use of Standard English, and health and physical capacity to teach.
- DBS and Health check required.

The Tuition Fee programme offers:

- full-time school-based training with University of Greenwich

- a personal tutor
- a choice to specialise in EYFS, KS1 or KS2
- support by mentors and experienced teachers within the schools and across the Trust
